## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Killed well with water and pulled tubing. Set 7" Baker Model K cement retainer @ 6300'. Cemented with 57 sacks of neat sack cement, 47 sacks below retainer and 10 sacks above retainer. Found top of cement @ 6221'. Perforated 7" csg from 6140' to 6160' - Brinkard sandy member (Tubbs section) of yeso formation - with 4 jet HPP by Lane-Wells.. Re-ran tubing and acidized with 1000 gallons by CP. Completed as gas well with an open flow capacity of 975 MCF daily, no oil or distillate.
