In reply to your letter of August 17th, regarding completion report on the Belcher #1 Well, the Form C-105, Well Record, was filed with us on April 1st, 1949.

The completion report you refer to could be the Proration Office Completion Report. We do not get this report in our office. As far as the Commission is concerned all necessary reports on this well have been filed.

You still refer to this well as your Hinton #10. We are not concerned with the way you number wells in your office, however, when the Notice of Intention to Drill, Form C-101, is filed with us we must have all reports from beginning drilling operations to completion and producing carried as the same well number. Also, reports filed with the different state departments must have the same well number.

Will you also check your records on the Elliott B-15 #1 or #2 well. The U.S.G.S. files show this to be the #1 Well, the Proration Office the #1 Well on one report and the #2 on another. Our approval on the Form C-110, Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil, is for a #2 Well. You can understand our position and I am sure you will straighten this matter out.
