FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We have cemented 5 1/2" 15 1/2' casing at 6372' with total depth of 7-7/8" hole being 6374'. Casing was cemented with 350 sacks and plug was pumped down at approximately 9:30 A.M. November 19, 1948.

We propose to allow cement a set time of 72 hours then go in hole with tubing; test casing; then drill cement. If cement job proves O K we will continue drilling in with reverse circulation to a depth of approximately 6510'.
