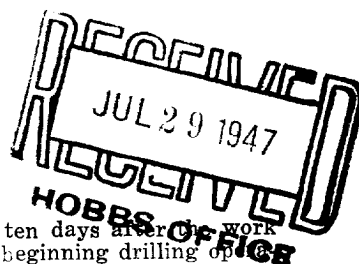

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Deepening operations were begun on June 5, 1947, when top of cement plug was found at 4015'. A 6-1/4" hole was drilled to a total depth of 6494' on July 3, 1947.

The hole was then plugged back to 6460' with cement and 1330' of 5" O.D. liner was

run and set at 6330'. The liner was cemented with 135 sacks of common cement on July 5, 1947.
