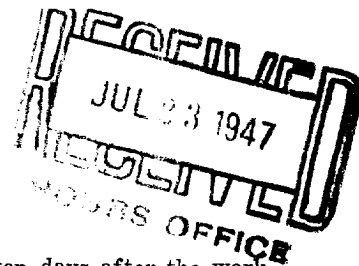

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The hole was washed down and the casing tested with 1200# pressure applied for 15 minutes. The plug was drilled and the casing tested with 1200# pressure applied for 15 minutes. Both tests were OK, and after approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.

The temperature survey shows the top of cement behind 9-5/8" casing at 1485' from the surface.
