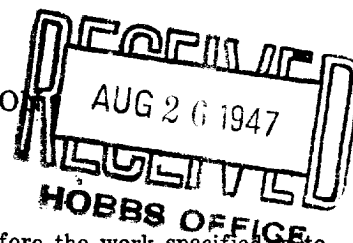

On August 25, 1947 ran 91 joints of 9-5/8" OD 35# 8 RD T&D. H - 40 Casing. Set at 2875', Cemented by HOWCO with 1200 sacks 2 1/2 Aquagel, and 100 sacks of Neat Bulk Cement. Plug went to 2839'. Job started 11:45 AM and completed at 3:00 PM.

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off at 8:00 PM August 27, 1947.
