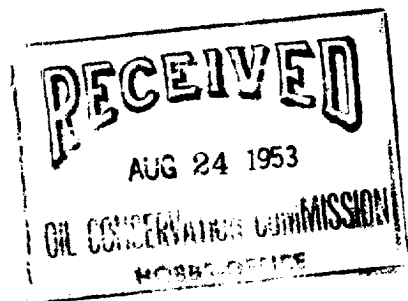

Gentlemen:

The Samedan Oil Corporation respectfully requests the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to issue approval authorizing the dual completion of its J. O. Parks Well No. 2 located 400 feet North of the South Line and 520 feet East of the West Line of Section 34, T-34N, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico in the Blinberry formation and the Drinkard formation and wishes to state the following in support thereof.

- (1) The subject well was completed as an oil well in the Drinkard formation on January 3, 1944.
- (2) The Samedan Oil Corporation now desires to complete the subject well in the Blinberry formation as a gas well, and states that with modern technique and equipment, it is both practical and economical to so dually complete the subject well in a manner such that there will be no interfering of fluids between the oil and gas reservoirs.
- (3) The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of the subject well and the 160 acre unit of location for its allowable purposes.
- (4) The attached Exhibit "B" shows the manner and method of the dual completion.
- (5) The approval of this application is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights, and the Samedan Oil Corporation will comply with all rules and regulations to maintain separation of fluid production from the two pay zones.
- (6) A copy of this application has been mailed to each offset operator.

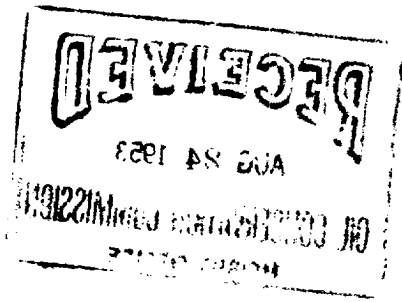
