Re: Application to dually complete Samedan Oil Corporation's Parks "A" No. 4, Brinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, Samedan Oil Corporation wishes to state the following:

- (a) That Samedan Oil Corporation's Parks "A" No. 4, located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 14-22N-37E, Lea County, was completed June 23, 1948, at a total depth of 6460 feet. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well on Samedan Oil Corporation's Parks lease and the location of all offset wells.
- (b) That subject well has 7" casing set at 6408 feet and was cemented with 500 sacks of cement. Top of cement by temperature survey was found at 6110 feet. The well produces oil from the open hole interval from 6408 to 6460 feet in the Brinkard Pool.
- (c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner which is shown schematically in the attached exhibit "B".
 - 1. Perforate the 7" casing within the intervals 6072 to 6078 feet and 6110 to 6140 feet in the Tubb Gas Pool.
 - 2. Set production type sucker below these perforations at 6200 feet to separate the Tubb Gas and Brinkard Oil zones.
 - 3. Produce the Brinkard Pool oil through the tubing and the Tubb Pool gas through the tubing - casing annulus.
- (d) That the granting of permission to produce the well as a

dual completion with oil from the Brinkard Pool and gas from the Tubbs Pool is in the interests of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

- (e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
- (f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.
- (g) That by copy of this letter of application, all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.

Therefore, Semedan Oil Corporation requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to the applicant to dually complete subject well as proposed in this application.

I hereby certify that all information given in this application is true and complete to the best of my knowledge.

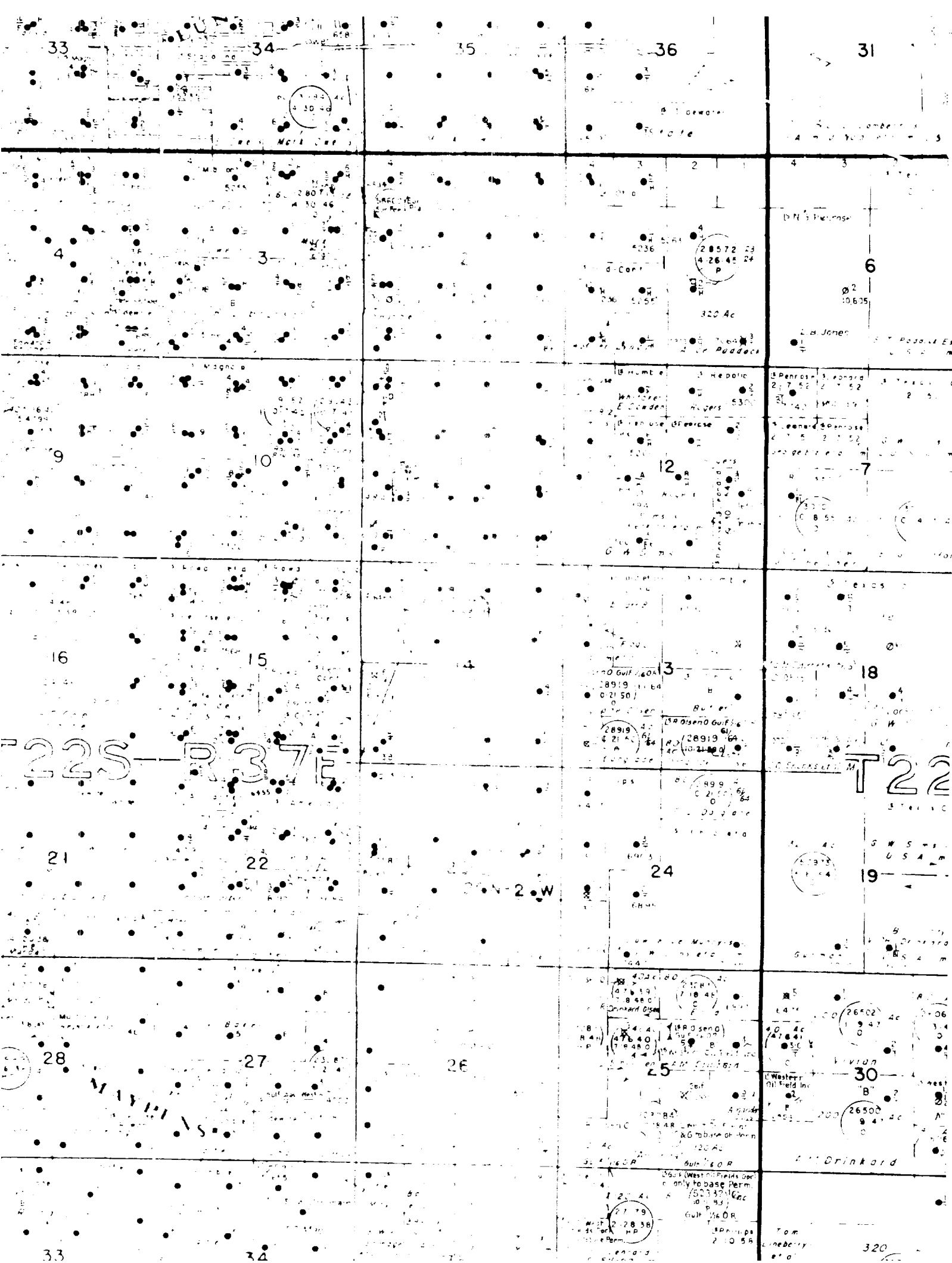
