FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was completed producing from the Drinkard pay from 6430' to 6455', flowing 12 barrels of oil per day. The well was stopped flowing and the amount of production is not sufficient to warrant the installation of pumping equipment; therefore, we have decided to abandon the well as a producer from the Drinkard formation. We propose to plug back to the bottom of the 4-inch casing, which was set at 6430', and perforate it opposite the gas zone from 640' to 6420', changing the well from its present status as an oil well to a gas well. The gas production from this well is to be sold to the El Paso Natural Gas Company.
