DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

7875' Total Depth, Granite. 7872' Drilled Out Depth. Acidised well with 500 gallons Western Mud Acid, pulled swab four times and well kicked off. Flowed and swabbed estimated 50 barrels into pits. Turned into tanks on 1/2" positive choke. In first 17 1/2 hours well flowed 677.54 barrels oil, 2/10%BSK no water, gravity 41.5 corrected. Gas volume 836,500 cu.ft. per day. Gas-Oil-Ratio 900. Tubing pressure 400#, casing pressure 0#. Well completed.
