7917' Total and Drilled Out Depth. Ran 500 gallons of Western Mud Acid and pulled swab five times. Well kicked off and for first 30 minutes flowed into pits. Swabbed and flowed estimated 45 barrels into pits. Turned into tanks and for 14.5 hour period well flowed 500.94 barrels of oil, 1/10% BS, on a 1/2" positive choke. Gas 455M per day, GOR 551, Gravity 42 corrected.
