Walden #6, Drinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico Gentlemen: By this letter of application Amerada Petroleum Corporation wishes to state the following: (a) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation E. W. Walden #6 located in SW/4 of the SW/4, Section 15, Township 22-S, Range 37-E was completed December 13, 1947 at a total depth of 8090'. The attached Exhibit A shows the location of this well on the Amerada E. W. Walden Lease together with the locations of all offset wells. (b) That subject well has 5 1/2" casing set at 8000' and cemented with 650 sacks cement. The well is an oil well producing from the perforated interval of 61415' to 6470' in the Drinkard Zone, Drinkard Pool. (c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner: (1) Perforate the 5 1/2" casing within the approximate intervals of 6000 to 6025' and 6075' to 6200' in the Tubbs Formation, Tubb Gas Pool. (2) Set production type packer below these perforations at approximately 6210' to separate the two zones. (3) Produce the Drinkard oil through the tubing and the Tubb gas through the tubing-casing annulus. (d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Tubb and oil from the Drinkard is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights. (e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones. (f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical. (g) That by copy of this letter of application all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.
