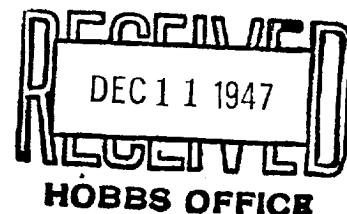

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6472' Drilled Out Depth. Acidized with 1000 gallons of Western 15% Low Tension Acid and spotted acid over perforations at 3:44PM, 12-5-47. Shut down, put on tree and resumed at 4:30PM. Formation broke at 1550' with 2½ bbls. of acid in formation. At 6:25PM at end of 25½ bbl. water flush tbg. was 1200'. Pulled swab 6 times and well kicked off. Flowed to pits on 1/4" choke for 45 minutes. Put on 1/2" choke and turned into tanks at 9:00PM. In 9 hours to 6:00AM well flowed 33.81 bbls. oil, 4% Acid Water, gas 738M, Gas-Oil-Ratio 8912 (Figured on last 3 hours). In next 8 hrs. well flowed 39.81 bbls. fluid, 1/2" choke, gas 770M, Gas-Fluid-Ratio 6447.
