6520' Drilled Out Depth. Acidized with 1000 gallons of Western 15% Low Tension Acid and started in at 12 noon. On formation at 12:20PM, 800# tbg., 1000# csg. Flush of 25-3/4 bbls. complete at 1:09PM, 2325# tbg., 1950# csg. Swabbed flush of 25-3/4 bbls. to tanks and swabbed estimated 40 bbls. acid water and water to pits. Turned back into tanks and in 8 hours to 6:00AM, 11-30-47, swabbed 72.72 bbls. of fluid, 90% water. Water tested 76,000ppm Chloride, very slight trace of iron. Show of gas for last three runs while pulling swab.
