DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8088' Drilled Out Depth. Spotted 5000 gallons of Western 15% Low Tension Acid over perforations at 9:40PM, 11-16-47 with 1500# on tubing, dropped to 1350#. Flush of 33 bbls. complete at 10:45PM with 2150# on tubing. In 4 hours flowed and swabbed an estimated 180 bbls. of acid water and oil to pits. Turned into tanks and in 13 hours swabbed 120.86 bbls. of oil, 2/10%BS, 2/10%water. Well shut in for 12 hours to 4:00AM, 11-18-47 and tubing built up to 150#, casing to 50#. Opened well and all gas bled off in 4 minutes, no production.
