**8088'** Drilled Out Depth. Spotted 500 gallons of Western Mud Acid over perforations at 5:45PM, 11-15-47. Pumped nine barrels into formation which broke at 1900# tubing pressure. Flush of 33 barrels complete at 6:25PM with 1600# tubing press. In 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  hrs. swabbed an estimated 70 bbls. of acid water and oil to pits. In 16 hrs. swabbed 77.28 bbls. to tanks, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  water, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ SS.
