Gentlemen: Letter of application Amerada Petroleum Corporation wishes  
By following:

to state that Amerada Petroleum Corporation E. W. Walden #7 located in  
SW/4 of Section 15, Township 22-S, Range 37-E, was completed  
SE/4, 1947 at a total depth of 6475'. The attached Exhibit A  
location of this well on the Amerada E. W. Walden Lease together  
No locations of all offset wells.

(b) That subject well has 5 1/2" casing set at 6475' and cemented with  
sacks cement. The well is an oil well producing from the perforated  
interval of 6435' to 6470' in the Drinkard Zone, Drinkard Pool.

(c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the  
following manner:

(1) Perforate the 5 1/2" casing within the approximate  
interval of 5450 to 5700', opposite the Blinbry Formation.

(2) Set production type packer below these perforations  
at approximately 5710' to separate the two zones.

(3) Produce the Drinkard oil through the tubing and the  
Blinbry gas through the tubing-casing annulus.

(d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce  
the well as a dual completion with gas from the Blinbry and oil from the  
Drinkard is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative  
rights.

(e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of  
the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of  
production from the two pay zones.

(f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is  
mechanically feasible and practical.

(g) That by copy of this letter of application all offset operators  
are notified of the proposed dual completion.
