A separate certificate shall be filed for each transporter authorized to transport oil from a unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the transporter, one copy returned to the producer, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operating ownership and each change in the transporter, except that in the case of a temporary change in the transporter involving less than the allowable production for one month the operator shall in lieu of filing a new certificate, notify the Oil Conservation Commission at Santa Fe, New Mexico, and the transporter authorized by certificate on file with the Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving oil from the unit and the name of such temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished such temporary transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more oil than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A temperature survey was run within 24 hours after plug had been pumped down on 5 1/2" casing cemented with 471 sacks at depth of 7748' and cement was found to have come back around casing to depth of approximately 5100'. Cement was allowed 72 hours set time and casing was then pressure tested. Same was found to be OK. and cement was drilled from casing. 35' of cement was found in bottom of casing. Hole was circulated to bottom, mud displaced with water, and water with oil.
