7869' Drilled out depth, Ran 250 joints 2" EUE 4.7" J-55, R2-, 8 1/2" Spang Seamless Steel tubing set at 7860' with 1-3' Perforated Nipple on bottom bull plugged, and 1-4' Sub on top, Put on Xmas Tree and spotted 500 gallons Western Mud Acid on bottom at 2PM and let it set 10 minutes and pressure dropped Casing 250#, Tubing Zero pumps in acid and flushed with 33.75 barrels oil Casing 475#, Tubing 1050', Opened up well and flowed for 5 minutes into pits estimate of 5 barrels and turned into tanks on 1/2" Choke and in 9 hours made 457.66 barrel oil, Gravity 43.9 corrected, gas volume 1,020M per day Gas-Oil-Ratio 837. Well completed
