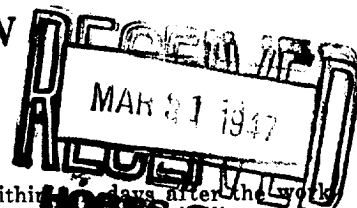

7870' Total Depth Granite, Finished laying down drill pipe at 8:30AM and ran Schlumberger Well Survey for 4 1/2 hours, Rigged up and ran 195 Jts 5 1/2" OD 17#, J-55, E-3, 8 PT, Spang Seamless Steel Casing and set at 7870' and cement with 550 Sacks Common and 50 Sacks Incor Cement and plug pumped to 7825' at 11:50PM March 28, 1947, final pressure 1600#, 6 Baker Centralizers set at 7654-7695-7737-7774-7815-7860.
