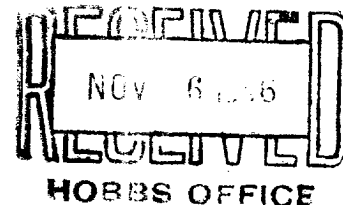

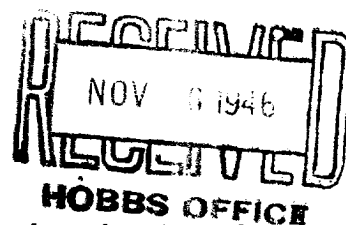

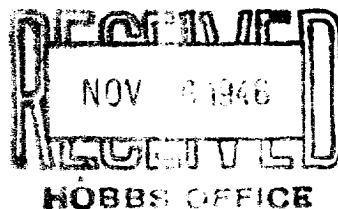

## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We propose to perforate the 5-1/2" OD casing with 3 shots per foot from 5162 to 5172'. If natural production is not obtained after a swabbing test, we further propose to acidize the perforated section with 2000 gallons of low surface tension non-emulsifying acid.
