
The captioned well is a Eumont Gas Well with 80-acres dedication. It is presently classified as a marginal gas well, however, in April, 1965 this well was put into a low pressure line.

This well's production for the year 1965 is listed below, along with the 80-acre non-marginal allowable for the same period:

From this it can be seen that this well is easily capable of producing an 80-acre non-marginal allowable. It is therefore, respectfully requested that this well be reclassified as a non-marginal gas well.
