The hole was washed down and the cement drilled out to the float located at 7456'. The casing was tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 minutes. The test was OK, and after approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to complete the well.

Temperature Survey shows top of cement behind 7" casing at 2905' from the surface.
