DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Installed Dempsey retrievable pump driven by a Manton Gaulin Series 200 Triplex power unit w/40 HP electric motor. Ran 257 joints 8050' of 2-3/8" tubing. Ran 319 joints 7901' of 1" Regular CW Steel line parallel to tubing from top of pump cavity to surface. Tubing set at 8061', perforations 7996'-7999'. Top of pump cavity at 7910', bottom of cavity 7930'. Standing valve in bottom of pump cavity at 7930'. Ran pump and rods.

RESULTS: Pumped On Oil Conservation Commission Test 13 bbls oil 3 bbls water thru tubing in 24 hours, 11 x 60" SPM. Formation gas volume TSTM. GOR none. Average daily production for January 1953 6 bbls oil 4 bbls water. Allowable before installing pumping equipment 11 bopd. Allowable after installing pumping equipment 13 bopd.
