Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising N/2 of Section 16, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and Two States Oil Company is operator of an oil and gas lease known as its R. E. Cole "B" Lease, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on the attached plat.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 320-acre gas proration unit in exception to Rule 5(a) of Order R-520.
- (3) The R. E. Cole "B" Well No. 6, located 1980 feet from the East line and 660 feet from the North line of Section 16, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed April 11, 1954, as a gas well. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (4) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the follow-
ing facts:

(1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and two leases are shown on the enclosed plat
creation of an oil and gas lease known as the R. F. Gulf Unit.

(2) This Oil Corporation proposes that the above described
section be established as a non-standard gas pro-
duction unit in accordance with Rule 5(a) of Order 15-220.

(3) The "R. F. Gulf" well No. 6, located 190 feet from the
East line and 80 feet from the North line of Section 16,
T-28S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed April
15, 1954, as a gas well. The applicant proposes to use this
well as one unit well.

(4) The proposed non-standard gas production unit will meet the
requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission
Order 15-220 as follows:

(a) Gas reserves quarter-quarter section will be
the unit.

(b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single govern-
mental section.
