DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Plugged back and recompleted as gas well in Queen formation as follows:

1. Spotted cement plug from 3698' to 3588'.
2. Perforated 5-1/2" casing from 3450-3468', 3492-3520', 3538-3542', 3552-3556', 3560-3564', and 3574-3580' with 4, 1/2" Jet Holes per foot.
3. Acid treated perforations in 5-1/2" casing with 800 gallons mud acid, May 14, 1953.
4. Acid treated perforations in 5-1/2" casing with 1000 gallons 15% NE acid June 14, 1953.
5. Petrofrac treated perforations in 5-1/2" casing with 6000 gallons with 6000# sand April 11, 1954.
6. Flowed at maximum rate of 770 MCF per day at back pressure of 544 psi on tubing.
