Gentlemen:

Under date of August 7, 1957, you applied for a hearing to form a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the W/2 W/2 of Section 17, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, in the Eumont Gas Pool. This unit is to be dedicated to your State "N" Well No. 12 located in the center of the SW/4 SW/4 of said section. That subject well is presently an oil well in the Eumont Gas Pool, but is to be recompleted as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool.

Under provisions of Rule 5 (a) and 5 (b) of Order R-520 it is possible to grant this application administratively. It will be processed as NSP-389 to be issued on September 11, 1957 providing there are no objections.
