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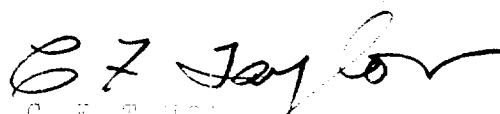
(f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

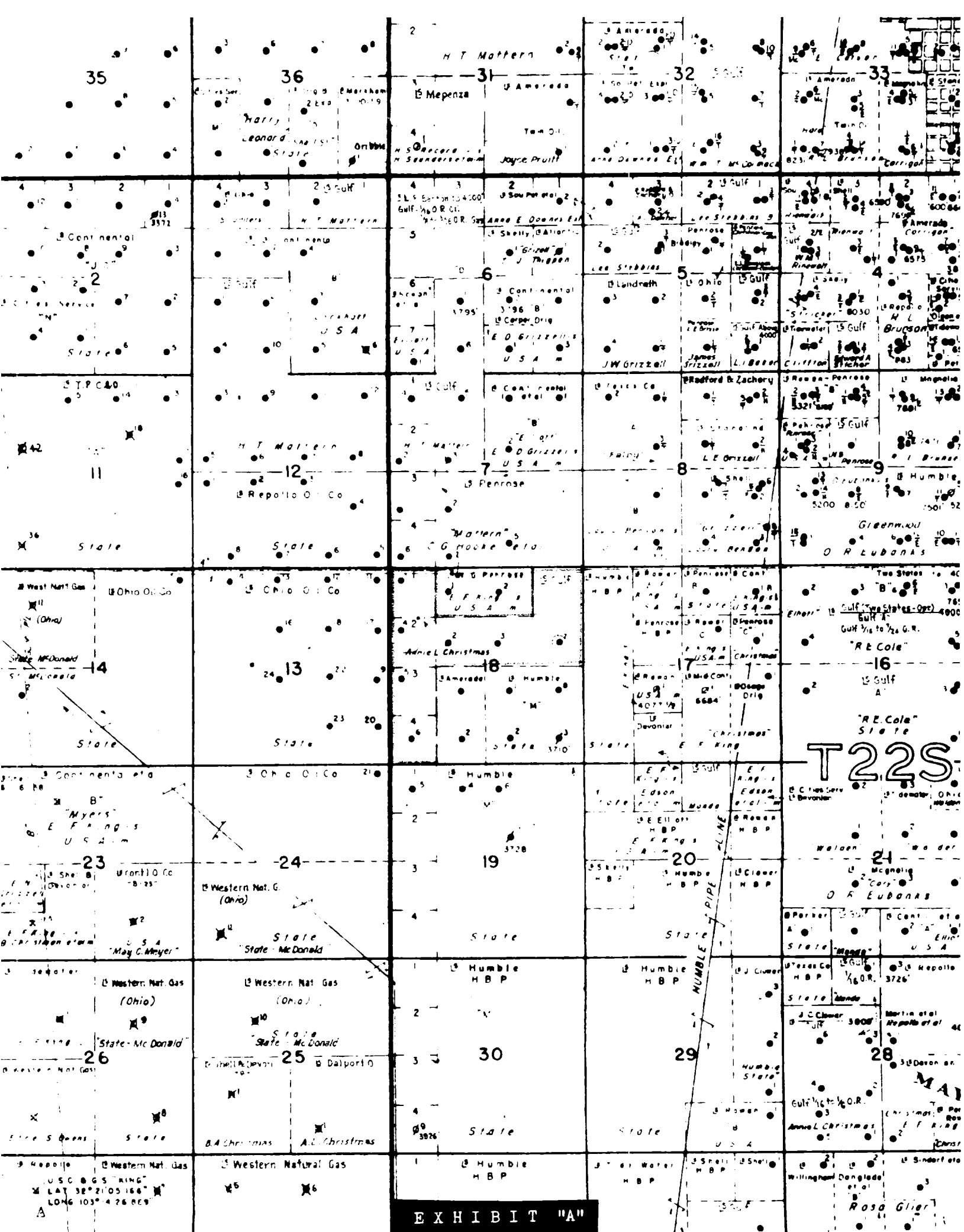


EXHIBIT "B"
