At the present time there are 6 producing wells on this property described as the W/2 of SW/4, W/2 of NW/4, SE/4 of NW/4, S/2 of NE/4, and the NE/4 of NE/4, of Section 18-22S-37E. The 6 wells are producing into a central battery consisting of three 625 barrel wood tanks and one 325 bbl wood tank.

Authority is requested to produce well #7, which is now drilling, into this battery with the other 6 wells. There is ample storage to take care of the 7 wells and by producing them all together will eliminate a substantial expenditure for additional tankage which is not needed at this time.
