Ran tubing open ended and plugged hole from TD of 3256' to 3056' with 25 sacks cement. Shot 5½" casing at 1000' and recovered 1000'. Spotted cement plug of 50 sacks cement from 1100' to 900' and plug of 100 sacks from 200' to surface. Interval between plugs filled with mud laden fluid. Installed regulation marker. Well plugged and abandoned.
