Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was drilled to 1415' in anhydrite. Ran 36.5 jts. (1399.01') of 8 5/8" OD 24# J-55 SS casing set at 1415' and cemented with 600 sacks 50% pozmix plus 200 sacks neat cement. Cement circulated. Plug was down 2:30 p.m., March 25, 1957. Cement was allowed to set 36 hours before testing for shut off. Prior to and after drilling plug, 1000 pounds pressure was applied with all valves closed, during a 30 minute interval with no drop in pressure. Drilling resumed.
