Gentlemen:

This is in regard to your Will Cary Well No. 1, in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 21, T. 22 S., R. 37 E.

The casing program I approved April 23, 1936, stated that the 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ " casing would be cemented with 300 sacks of cement. The 7" casing was to have been cemented with 200 sacks. I notice by form C-105, "Well Record" that the 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ " casing was cemented with only 150 sacks of cement and the 7" casing was cemented with only 50 sacks. What precaution was taken to protect the surface waters?

Also, I am enclosing herewith a Report Requirement List showing the delinquent reports on the above-mentioned well.
