DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Rigged up pulling unit, pulled 2" tubing, cleaned out to 3604' w/ reverse circulating system. Proposed to treat open hole interval (3385' - 3604') down casing, w/ 10,000 gal. Dowell Petro-Jell containing 1# per gal. sand. Broke formation down at 1500# PSI. took fluid at 1900# PSI. injected 12.2 bbl per min. at 2000# PSI. Flushed w/ 10,000 gal. lease oil. Job started 7:30 AM, 8/2/55, Job finished at 8:30 AM 8/2/55. Shut well in 24 hrs. Released pressure, cleaned out to bottom w/ reverse circulating system. Well is now back on production. Increased production to 74 bbls. per day.
