DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

7522' Drilled Out Depth. Ran American Hook Wall Packer and 241 jts. of 2" EUE, 4.7#, J-55, R-2, 8-RT, SS Tubing New with 1-8' sub on top of string, 1-6' sub on Packer, 1-8' & 2-6' subs below Packer and 1-3' perf. sub plugged on bottom of tubing. Packer swinging at 7524' and bottom of tubing swinging at 7520'. Spotted 500 gals. of Western Regular Acid on formation at 12:07PM, 12-30-47. Oil flash of 30.83 bbls. complete at 12:25PM, 1650# pressure. Well kicked off through both tubing and casing without being swabbed at 12:45PM. Turned to pits and at 2:00PM turned to tanks on 1/2" positive choke. In 15 hour test to 6:00AM, 12-31-47, well flowed 497.95 bbls. oil, gas 845M per day, Gas-Oil-Ratio 1061, gravity 42.9 corrected. Well completed.
