### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

**7522' Drilled Out Depth. Acidized with 1000 gals. of Western 15% Low Tension Acid and started acid over perforations at 6:35PM. Could not jay packer, laid down 6 jts. of tubing and pumped acid into formation with 3400# tubing and 2500# held on casing. Oil flush of 31 bbls. complete at 10:23PM and could not lower tubing. Packer now set at 7175' with bottom of tubing at 7325'. Tested packer with 800# for 5 minutes and OK. Rigged up and started swabbing at 12:30AM, 12-29-47. Swabbed 23.46 bbls. load oil to tanks and turned to pits. To 12 noon recovered 1000 gals. acid water and lead oil and to 3:00PM recovered nothing. Pulled tubing and packer and perforated with Lane Wells from 7427' to 7520', 372 holes. Ran tubing and packer back in the hole.**
