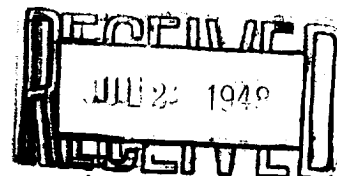

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6421' Drilled Out Depth. Acidized with 500 gallons Western 15% Low Tension Acid and ran 10 bbls. oil ahead of acid. Started acid down tubing at 3:33PM, 6-25-48, on bottom at 6:04PM and treatment complete at 6:16PM. Pressures: Tbg. 2400#, Csg. 2750#. Swabbed well 2 1/2 hrs. and well kicked off. Let well clean up, put on 1/4" choke and in 24 hrs. well flowed 110.40 bbls. oil, 0% BS&W, gas, 214,728 cu.ft. per day, GOR 1945. Gravity 37.4 corrected. Well completed.
