DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6441' Plugged Back Depth. Acidized with 1000 gallon Western 15% Low Tension Acid. Had about 200' of fluid in bottom of hole and did not open packer. Pumped acid down tubing and hole went on vacuum. All acid and 25 bbls. oil flush went in on vacuum. Complete at 7:05PM, 9-21-48 and resumed swabbing. In next 11 hrs. swabbed 46.92 bbls. fluid, 50% water. Swabbed to midnite and recovered 59.34 bbls. fluid, 20% water. Shut well in 5 1/2 hrs. and tubing pressure built up to 125#. Opened well and gas off in 4 min. Fluid hit in 12 minutes and in 3/4 hrs. flowed .35 bbls. fluid, gas decreasing.
