2763' Total Depth, Lime. Ran temperature survey and found top of cement at 97', 40.4% of calculated fill. Nipped up 8-5/8" Casing, went in hole with 7-3/8" bit and drilled out cement from 2680' - 2763'. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes before and after drilling cement and OK. Started drilling 7-3/8" hole from 2763' at 7:30PM, 10-10-48.
