DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well with rotary tools at the above location to a depth of approximately 7800' unless commercial oil or gas production is encountered at a lesser depth. All casing will be cemented in accordance with methods approved by the U. S. Geological Survey. Any other special requirements will be complied with. The following casing pattern will be used:

- 13-3/8" Casing to be set at approximately 300' and cemented with 285 sacks cement.
- 9-5/8" Casing to be set at approximately 2750' and cemented with 1050 sacks cement.
- 7" Casing to be set at approximately 7800' and cemented with 1040 sacks cement.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

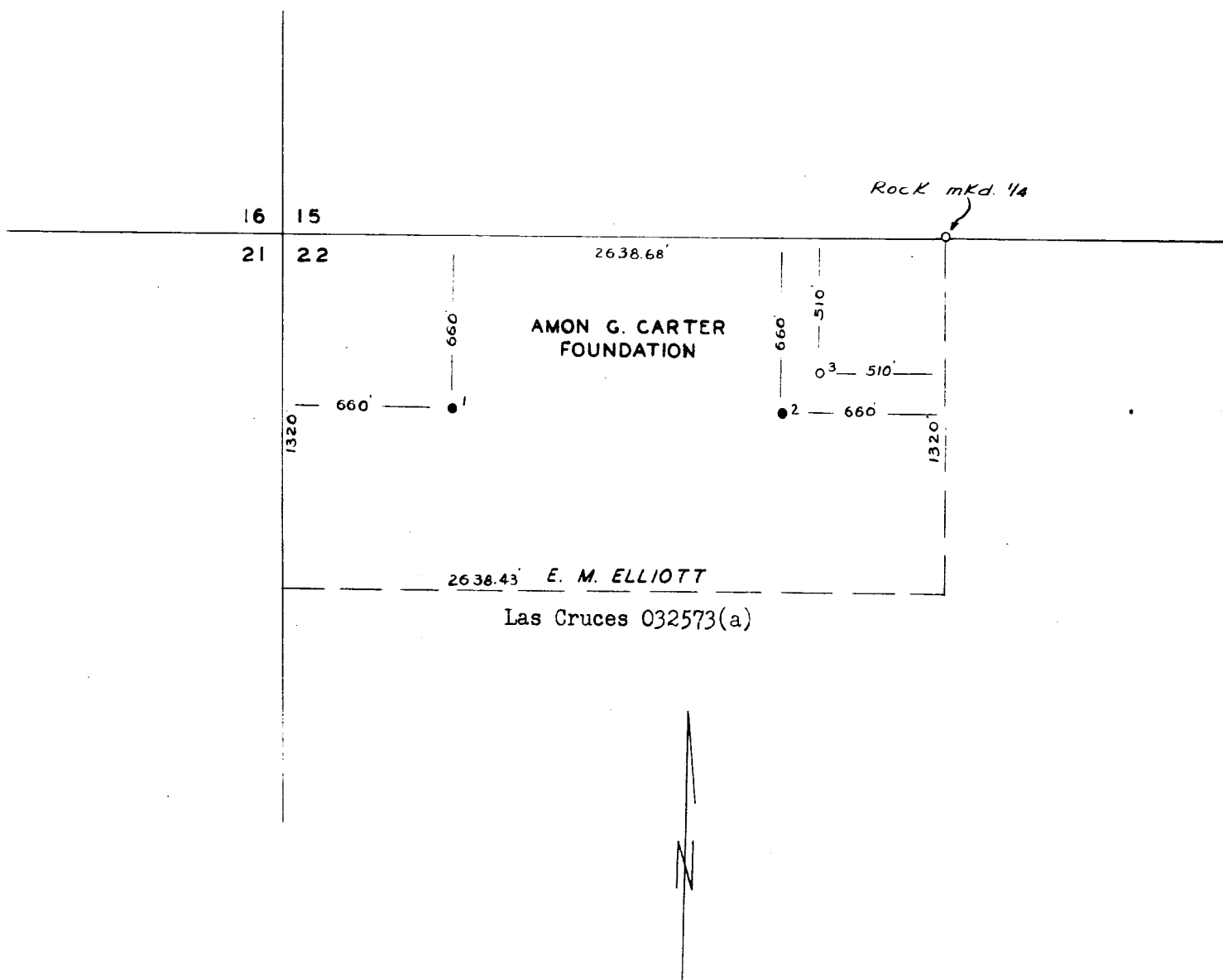
