DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8040' Drilled out depth, Acidized with 500 Gallons of Western Mud Acid, spotted acid over perforations at 7:07PM, let it set 13 minutes, washed over perforations and spotted fresh bunch of acid over perforations, and pressured up with 2000#, let it set 3 minutes and pressure dropped to 1500#, resumed pumping and pumped acid into formation with 2000# pressure and at end of 32 bbls flush oil, Casing 2000#, Tubing 2000#, rigged up and swabbed from 8 Pm into tanks and pits until 2AM and well started flowing and put on 1/2" Positive choke and in 9 hours made 72.45 bbls oil, gas volume 156M per day Gas-Oil-Ratio 753, Casing 25#, Tubing 50#.
