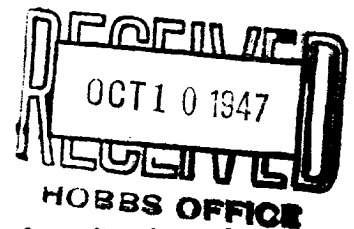

Ran total of 203 joints of 5 1/2" OD, 17# and 15.5#, J655, R-3, 8-RT S casing New with 50 jts. of 17# on bottom, 74 jts. of 15.5# in the middle and 79 jts. of 17# on top and casing set at 8116'. Cemented with 600 sacks of regular bulk cement and 50 sacks of Incon Cement and plug pumped to 7949' at 2:00PM, 10-7-47. Final pressure 1300#. Six Baker Centralizers set at 7951', 7961', 8011', 8041', 8071', 8101'.
