On July 6, 1945 the 9 5/8" O.D. 36# 8 Rnd. Thd. Grade H Range 2 Pittsburg S.S. Casing was cemented in Anhydrite at 2,879' with 1200 sacks of 2% Aquagel and 100 sacks of neat cement by Halliburton. Job completed at 6:00 P.M. and the plug pumped to 2,844'.

Propose to drill plug and test shut off at 6:00 P.M. on July 9, 1945.
