R. Olsen Oil Company, Company or Operator, Boyd, Lease, Well No. 1, in the NE 1/4 of Sec. 23, T. 22S, R. 37E, N. M. P. M., Drinkard Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5 1/2" casing was reported on March 9, 1946 as having been cemented at depth of 6365'. Plug was drilled on March 11, 1946 and steel line run as soon as bit drilled through shoe. Bottom of shoe was found, by this procedure, to be at 6333'. It is obvious that one joint of casing was tallied twice; hence the error in report. Total depth of hole by steel line is 6419'.

Casing and formation around shoe have both been pressure tested.
