FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was drilled to 1855 feet and temporarily abandoned. We now plan to go back into Boyd #2 and drill it down to 5550 feet, or possibly 6000 feet, into the gas sections and complete it as a gas well, setting 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing around 5420 feet or at 6000 feet, if drilled to that depth. If an intermediate string of casing is not run, enough cement will be used to circulate to the top, otherwise 300 sacks will be used.
