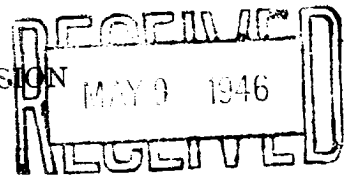

We cemented 13-3/8" casing at 291' with 300 sacks and circulated cement back into the cellar. Plug was pumped down at midnight May 6, 1946. Total depth of hole is 300' in red beds.

We propose to allow cement 48 hours set time before drilling plug.
