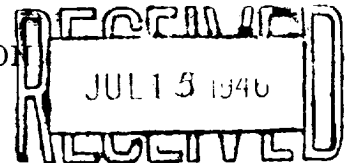

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

A string of 5" casing (15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ") was cemented at 6324' with 400 sacks on July 12, 1946 at 10:00 A. M. Total depth of hole was 6325'.

Cement will be allowed approximately 72 hours in which to set before plug is drilled and casing is pressure tested. If test proves O. K., hole will be deepened to a depth of approximately 6420'.

We cemented 2391' of 8-5/8" thirty two pound casing at 2404' with 450 sacks on June 7, 1946. Plug was pumped down at 4:30 P.M. We propose to allow cement 48 hours set time before drilling plug and testing casing.

Casing is cemented approximately 55 feet below the base of salt.
