## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5" O.D. 13# casing was cemented at 6434' (corrected from 6438') with 200 sacks. Cement was allowed 48 hours set time before enough was drilled out of casing to permit gun perforating. Casing was perforated, after 72 hours set time on cement, with 4 shots per foot from 6402' to 6422'. Hole was then swabbed dry and showed only a trace of oil.

Casing was pressure tested before being perforated.
