Dear Mr. LeMay:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval for the creation of a non-standard 80 acre Blinebry Gas Proration Unit, approval of a non-standard gas well location for the Amanda # 3 and simultaneous dedication with the Amanda # 1.

Chevron U.S.A. is planning to add Blinebry gas zone perfs to the existing Blinebry completion in the Amanda # 3. The location of the proposed recompletion is 330' FSL and 1650' FEL in Section 25, T22S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. This well is currently a standard Blinebry oil well location and will become a non-standard gas well location, as it is only 330' from the quarter-quarter line.

The Amanda # 3 is dedicated to a standard 40 acre Oil Proration Unit which consists of the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 25, T22S, R37E. The Amanda # 1 is dedicated to a 40 acre non-standard gas proration unit, as submitted November 21, 1994 to the NMOCD, which consists of the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 25, T22S, R37E. The proposed 80 acre unit will consist of these two 40 acre tracts.
