Gentlemen:

In compliance with Commission orders dated November 10, 1953, pertaining to gas proration in the defined gas pools, Lea County, New Mexico, we are submitting herewith gas well plats, Form C-104, Request for (Oil)-(Gas) Allowable, and Form C-110, Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil and Natural Gas, for Gulf Oil Corporation's Amanda Lease Well No. 1, located in Section 25, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This gas well is producing from the Tubb Gas Formation and is in the Tubb Gas Pool.

As stated on the gas well plat, we are dedicating 120 acres to this well. We were contemplating the unitization of our 120 acres with Western Oil Fields' 40 acres to form a standard 160-acre proration unit comprising the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 25, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico; however on completing our well we learn they now have a Tubb Gas well on their 40 acres. Negotiations with Western Oil Fields are still in progress, but pending the completion of negotiation we request assignment of a 120-acre allowable immediately.
