Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed your Forms C-102, C-103 and C-104 for the subject well. This well has been plugged back from the Brunson Drinkard-Abo, South and the Upper Blinebry squeezed.

The well was reperforated lower in the Blinebry, acidized and fraced. The subject well tested 29 BOPD plus 210 MCF of gas per day. This gas-oil ratio of 7241 classified the well as a Blinebry oil well. Please cancel the Blinebry gas allowable and assign a Blinebry oil allowable. A Form C-102 for acreage dedication is enclosed.

Also attached is a letter to your Santa Fe Office requesting permission to surface commingle the Brunson Drinkard-Abo, South, Wantz Granite Wash and Blinebry Oil. A temporary approval is requested until this application can be approved at the state level.
